The Sudanese Organization for Research and Development (SORD) is a national, membership-based, non-governmental and not-for-profit organization registered under Sudan's Voluntary and Humanitarian Work Act. Established in 2007, SORD works at national level and through state-level offices to support communities and strengthen inclusive, locally led development.

SORD's work is rooted in livelihoods, gender equality and governance. In response to the needs of people affected by conflict, displacement and migration, the organization has expanded its humanitarian response portfolio while maintaining its commitment to long-term resilience and peacebuilding.

Our Operational Approach

SORD applies a Humanitarian–Development–Peace (HDP) Nexus approach. This approach connects immediate assistance with sustainable development, conflict sensitivity, social cohesion and the leadership of women, youth and community-based organizations.

Establishing CSO network (Sudanese Network For safe migration and counter human trafficking), setting its structure, electing its coordination body and agreeing on its objectives and roles. Undertaking profiling exercise for the members of the safe migration and counter human trafficking. Organizing a seminar on domestic worker vulnerability targeting the members of the Sudanese Network For Safe Migration And Combating Human Trafficking. Building block for a suggested referral system for domestic workers in Khartoum including its SOPs.
